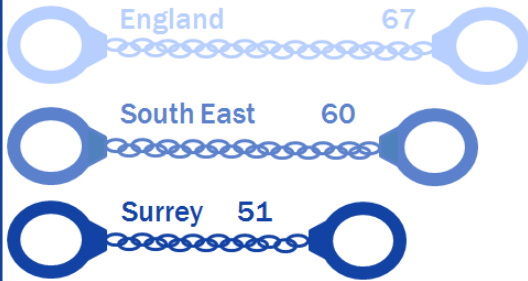
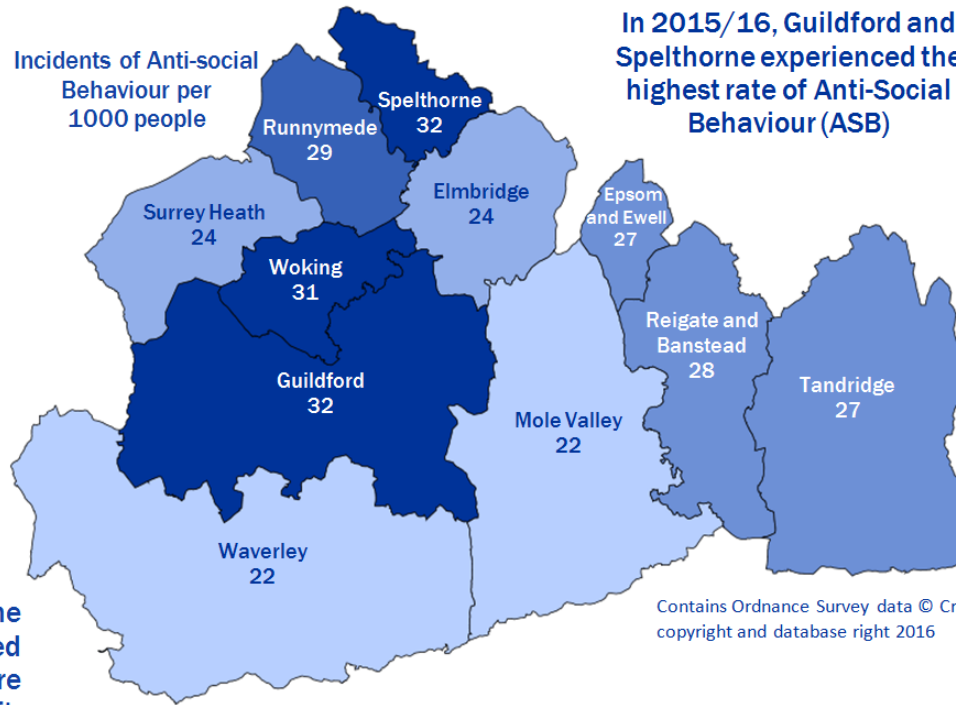


Crime and safety in Surrey

With 51 offences per 1000 people, Surrey's crime rate is 24% less than the England average¹



Incidents of Anti-social Behaviour per 1000 people

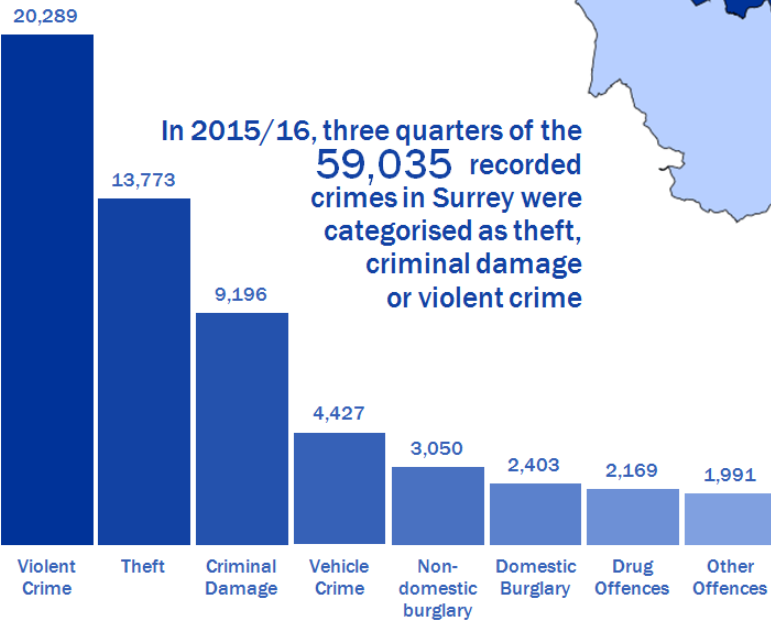


In 2015/16, Guildford and Spelthorne experienced the highest rate of Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)
