

Surrey Pay Multiple 2019/2020

The minimum Surrey Pay rate paid on grade PS1/2 is set at £9 per hour as at 1 April 2019, this compares with the statutory National Living Wage of £8.21 per hour for those aged 25 years and over (April 2019) and the “UK Living Wage”, of £9 per hour for those living outside London, which is advocated by the Living Wage Foundation (November 2018).

Based on salaries paid with effect from 1 April 2019 it is estimated that the Council will have the following ratios between the lowest and highest paid staff on Surrey Pay for the 2019/2020 financial year.

Surrey Pay Salary Ratios April 2019 – March 2020

Highest Basic Salary	£220,000	n/a
Median Basic Salary	£27,099	8.1:1
Lowest Basic Salary	£16,894	13:1

Notes:

- (i) The ratios have been calculated in accordance with guidance published in The Code of Recommended Practice for Local Authorities on Data Transparency 2011 and in light of recommendations contained in the Hutton Review of Fair Pay in the Public Sector 2011.
- (ii) The median is defined as the mid-point of the total number of staff employed.
