Surrey Pay Multiple 2020/2021

The minimum Surrey Pay rate paid on grade PS1/2 is set at £9.30 per hour as at 1 April 2020. This compares with the statutory National Living Wage of £8.72 per hour for those aged 25 years and over (April 2020) and the "UK Living Wage", of £9.30 per hour for those living outside London, which is advocated by the Living Wage Foundation (November 2019).

Based on salaries paid with effect from 1 April 2020 the Council will have the following ratios between the lowest and highest paid staff on Surrey Pay for the 2020/2021 financial year.
